

Pupil Premium Strategy

Pupil Premium Funding is in addition to the main school funding from the government.

This funding is allocated to address the current underlying inequalities between children eligible for free school meals (FSM) and their peers.

All families who meet the criteria can apply for this funding for their child/ren. Currently, pupils in Reception, years 1 and 2 receive a free school lunch, however it is very important that those children eligible for Pupil Premium funding claim this additional support by letting the school office know that the family receive the following support:

- income Support
- income Based Jobseekers Allowance
- an income-related employment and support allowance
- support under part V1 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs) that does not exceed £16,190

In addition to covering the cost of school meals, the Pupil Premium (£1300) grant also entitles your child to a range of free activities to support their learning.

- Breakfast Club Voucher – a **free** breakfast at school for 15 days each half term.
- Reduction in costs of a school trip
- Chance of a **free** place in an afterschool club
- **Free** learning booster sessions to support your child's learning
