



Guidance for the use of children's images at WEPA.

We have lots of exciting events that take place at school and during these events we sometimes take photographs of children taking part in the activities. We use some of these photographs to put on display around the school. They may also be shown on our school website or in our monthly newsletter.

WEPA aims to provide advice and guidance in order to safeguard children and young people. Its aim is to minimise the risk of misuse of images and to ensure that individuals' safety and welfare are not compromised.

Parents are first informed before pictures of children are taken from an event where the images may be used outside of school or the website. Names of children are not used.

A consent form is given in by parents to allow their child's photograph to be displayed on the school premises, in a newsletter or on the academy's website. Names of children are not used.

Taking pictures and videos of children and young people's achievements and activities is a wonderful way of capturing memories and promoting successes.

It is important that once you have recorded any images e.g. from assemblies, they are stored securely.
