

### SCHOOL TRIPS Haleema

Wood End Park Academy students were treated to some fantastic trips during the Autumn.

Year 4 paid a visit to the Science Museum. The Science Museum is a major museum in South Kensington, London. It was founded in 1857 and is one of the city's major tourist attractions, attracting 3.3 million visitors annually!

The Year 6 classes visited a Buddhist temple in Wimbledon. Buddhist Temples are called Viharas. Did you know The Viharas in India were originally constructed to shelter the monks

during the rainy season, when it became difficult for them to lead the wanderer's life!

Year 5 have been learning about Sikhism and so they visited a Gurdwara in Southall. A Gurdwara is a Sikh place of worship. Did you know that in Gurdwaras there are langars.

This is the community kitchen of a Gurdwara, which serves meals to all free of charge, regardless of religion, caste, gender, economic status, or ethnicity. People sit on the floor and eat together, and the kitchen is maintained and serviced by Sikh community volunteers!

#### **Online Bullying**

Online bullying is sometimes referred to as cyberbullying.

According to the Cyberbullying Research Centre, cyberbullying is harm that is purposefully and persistently committed via computers, phones, and other electronic devices.

Cyberbullying is the practice of engaging in overt or covert bullying behaviours while using digital technology, such as hardware like computers and smartphones and software like social networking and instant messaging.

#### **Covert Bullying**

Bullying that goes unnoticed is frequently called "covert bullying" and might happen behind the victim's back. It is intended to degrade someone's reputation in society and/or make them feel humiliated. Lying and spreading rumours are two examples of social bullying. hostile body language, threatening or dismissive stares offensive making iokes humiliate and disgrace

We have Anti-Bullying Week because at WEPA we can stop all of this. So, continue to show courage and let someone know if you hear of somebody who is being bullied in any form.

Mobile phones, tablets and laptops can open up a world of exploration, learning and fun and children should be encouraged to make the most of the benefits. But there are also risks and dangers to being online, and by

working together parents and children can learn to safely navigate the internet and social media. Here are some top tips on how to keep safe online during Christmas:

- Explain how children can use privacy settings to make sure only approved friends can see posts and images, and warn them about sharing personal information.
- Check if any of the mobile apps they use have location services enabled, and disable this if they do not want to be tracked.
- Show them how to report offensive comments or block people who upset them.
- Check 'tagging' settings so that when others are posting or sharing photos online, your child's identity is not revealed.
- Encourage your child to come and talk to you if they see anything that upsets them.
- Ask them to show you which social media apps they use, what they like about them and talk about how to use them safely.
