Dispersal

The action or process of distributing or spreading things over a wide area.

"Dispersal of pollen by the wind"



Seed

A small, round or oval object produced by a plant and from which, when it is planted, a new plant can grow.



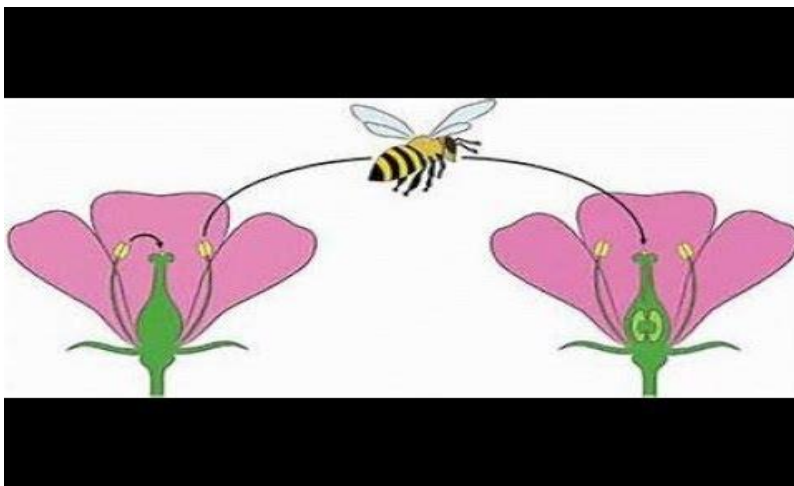
Germinate

When a seed begins to grow.



Pollination

The process in which pollen is taken from one plant or part of a plant to another so that new plant seeds can be produced.



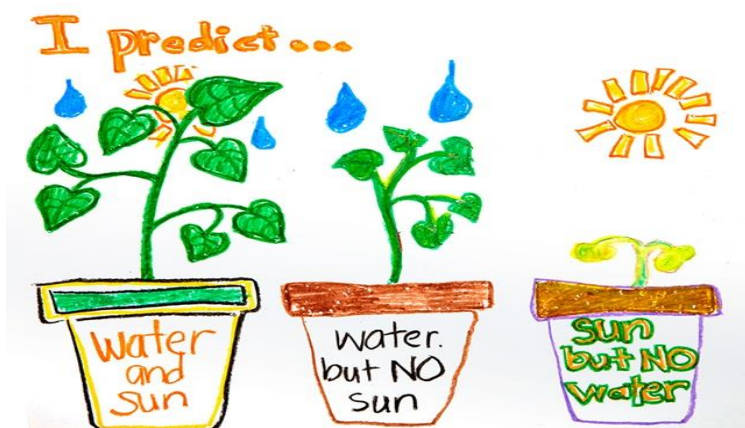
Observe

To see, watch or notice something.



Prediction

A statement that someone makes about what they think is going to happen.

Growth

The process of increasing in size



Experiment

A scientific test which is done in order to discover what happens to something in particular conditions.



Measure

The use of a ruler to determine the length of an object.
