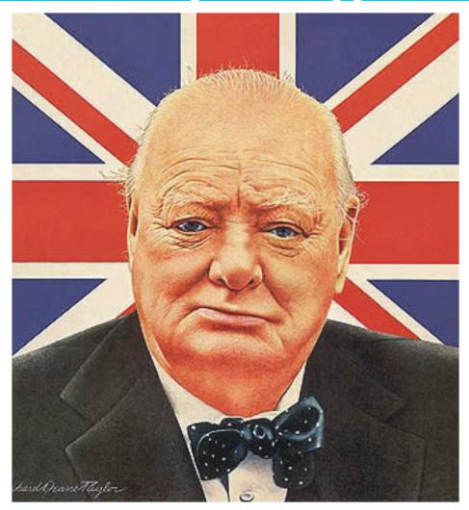

- Winston Churchill – was the British prime minister during world war two, who led the allied forces to victory.
- When you look at his qualities, you can see he had
  - Good communicator – he made some of the most famous speeches in history
  - Inspiring – he rallied the British people in the face of adversary
  - Passionate – He was passionate about the betterment of his country and winning the war
  - Sense of humour – he was known for having a sharp wit and quick one liners
  - Courageous – making the tough decisions, when other may have faltered
