Books to read at home



Read some fun books about animals and the zoo – learn about different animals and describe what they look like. Focus on the 5 senses when describing (look, hear, feel, smell and taste). Read some RSPCA books that discuss real-life rescues. Explain about the nature of charities and how we can help.

Maths learning

Have fun looking at sizes of different animals. Which one is the tallest? Which is the widest? Put them in order from smallest to biggest!

Charity week

Choose a charity of your choice and make a donation this week. This should come from your child and be meaningful for them. It could be a few pennies saved from the tooth fairy or a toy that they no longer play with.

Discuss the importance of giving and being kind and the impact this has on the less fortunate. This will have a lasting impact on your child and will help develop them into kind and considerate beings.
