



Summer 1 Theme 3:	Heroes (Knights and Dragons + Supertato)
What can you do at home?	
Books to read at home	<div style="display: flex; align-items: flex-start;">  <div style="margin-left: 10px;"> <p>A fantastic book about a superhero potato and an evil pea to teach all about heroes!</p> </div> </div> <div style="display: flex; align-items: flex-start; margin-top: 10px;">  <div style="margin-left: 10px;"> <p>Lots of fun videos about Mike The Knights adventures too!</p> </div> </div> <p>Discuss the heroes and knights in these stories/ video clips. What are the common features/ traits? E.g. brave. Why must a hero have this trait?</p>
Maths learning	<p>Imagine your superhero power is seeing doubles! Look at different items around the house (e.g. mobiles) and try to double these.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you half these instead by sharing equally?</p>
Science experiment/ Understand the World	<p>The two dragons in Mike the Knight breathe fire/ squirt water.</p> <p>With an adult leading, light a candle or matchstick. Then model putting this out with water. What happens to the flame? Why does this happen?</p> <p>Teach your child scientific methods, such as predicting what will happen beforehand and then noting the results afterward. Was this in line with their prediction – if not, how was the result different to what you expected?</p> <p>NOTE: ADULT SUPERVISION REQUIRED.</p>
