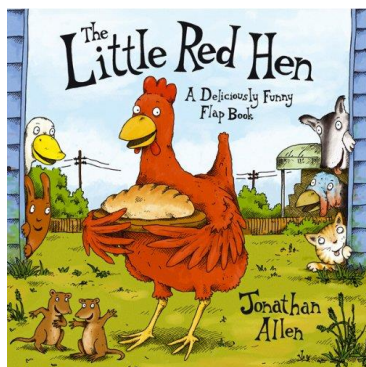

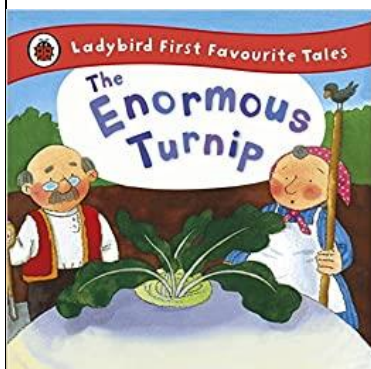
Growing/ planting on a farm
