




	<p><b>Gender</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 'All about me' learning in Autumn term.</li> <li>• Circle times discussing gender.</li> <li>• Encourage the children to participate in play where they can explore all sorts of roles and jobs.</li> <li>• It is important to challenge stereotypes early and promote gender equality.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Relationship</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Circle times discussing relationships.</li> <li>• Define, model and give examples of what a healthy relationship is.</li> <li>• Supporting interactions with others</li> <li>• Learning how to make good friendships, co-operate and resolve conflicts peacefully.</li> <li>• Learning about different types of relationships; friends; with teachers; families.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Age</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 'All about me' learning in Autumn term.</li> <li>• We learn about celebrations, and talk about birthdays.</li> <li>• We talk about past and present birthdays and how old pupils are.</li> </ul>
