This is an example of a report on a product. What other reports could you read at home?

I have used the 'Pack-it-in-Bag' for a week now, in place of my normal school bag. Having tested the product, I am well equipped to offer a true reflection of what the product can offer and any limitations that it may have- with suggested improvements.

The 'Pack-it-in-Bag' works quite well as it is strong and comfortable. Due to the width of the material on the strap, it sits comfortably on the shoulder so that it does not rub against the collar bone. Even after using the rucksack on a long walk, it remained snug against my body. The bag claims that it can hold 15kg of weight and although I only carried 6kg, I feel confident that it could easily hold much more.

However, there are drawbacks. I noticed that as soon as I got the bag, that the zips on the front pockets moved from outside to in. This is not very practical as the zips look as if they are closed - but they are actually open. On several occasions I have walked home and found the insides of these pockets absolutely saturated. May I suggest that you turn the zips on these pockets around or use a different fastener (possibly a strong Velcro or a buckle).

One of its biggest strengths is the varied selection of pocket sizes within the bag, making it easy to store a range of stationary and equipment for school. Despite this it would be beneficial to narrow the pen slots as my pens keep falling through. Most of the class (including myself) have pens without the necessary clips therefore the slots are being neglected.

Overall the 'Pack-it-in-Bag' is quite successful and will be significantly improved when the pockets and fastenings have been adjusted. The backpack received many positive comments including compliments to its style and colour. Ms Johra stated that "This bag is smart and has the potential to become the bag of choice at Wood End Park Academy."
