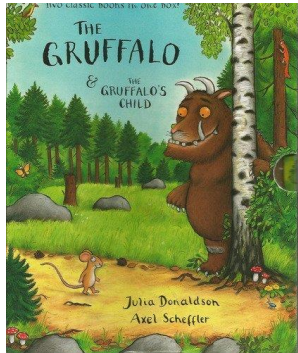


## What can you do at home?

Books to read at home

Award winning books written by Julia Donaldson – please do read the stories of The Gruffalo and The Gruffalo's child. Talk about the rhyme and rhythm in these books and also the habitats of the different animals!



Maths learning

This week we are looking at one more and one less. Play the one more/less game with your child where you say a number and they are to tell you what number is one more or one less. For example, 6 is one more than 5!

Technology

Stage a 'Gruffalo break-in' by messing up a room in the house! Have chairs upside down and toys on the floor!

Oh dear! It looks like the Gruffalo has broken in! Ask your child to use a camera/ phone/ tablet to take pictures and record the room. These will come in handy to show the big bad mouse! Be sure to explain that the Gruffalo is just pretend and it was you in fact who messed up the room!

The focus should be on using Technology for a purpose.

Challenge: Child to use the gallery feature to find the photo/ recording they have taken and show another family member!
