

## Google Classroom Home Learning Year 6

1st January 2021

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware, the government announced that some schools will be opening on Monday 18th January for the Spring term

Wood End Park Academy will be providing home learning for the period of 4th to 15th January. This will be done through:

1. Online tutoring
2. Work posted on Google Classroom and
3. Additional resources on the school website.

It is compulsory that all children complete the online work set and attend the online tutoring sessions. Children will be set up into a group and will be tutored daily via google meet , the minimum being one subject per day.

The group information will be uploaded onto your child's google classroom account. Please look out for this.

The teacher will be sending out the invitations for your child to attend a tutoring session. Do check your email inbox.

However, we will have daily English, Maths, Reading and Non-Core work to complete and hand in on google classroom. These pieces will be uploaded to google classroom and be on the website. Teachers will be marking all the work submitted and will be available to support your child in the google classroom work each afternoon ( in the morning the teacher will be tutoring).

### **Tips for Good online Tutoring :**

- All children are expected to attend the online tutoring sessions daily as well as complete the tasks set. This is via google meet at a time during the morning
- The children are expected to stay online for the whole tutoring session.
- They need to ensure that the camera is turned on throughout the session.
- Please show your child how to mute when the teacher is teaching. This will ensure there are no interruptions and noise in the background as the teacher is teaching.

- Your child needs to sit in a quiet room when the online tutoring session is taking place. Please ensure that no private conversations are occurring in the background and that no confidential information is shared on the screen and in the background.
- If a sibling's online tutoring sessions clashes, please notify the teacher so that another time could be arranged.
- Children need to follow their group's timetable each day.
- Remind children that both google meet and google classroom are professional learning platforms and that behavior expectations are the same as in school.
