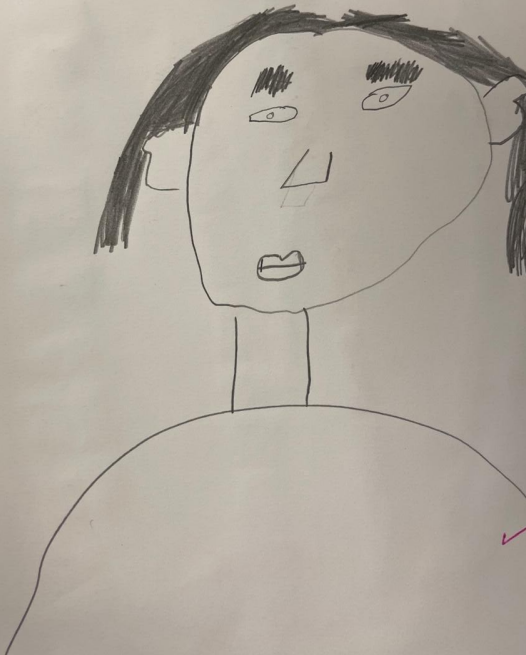

LQ: Can I can draw a self-portrait?

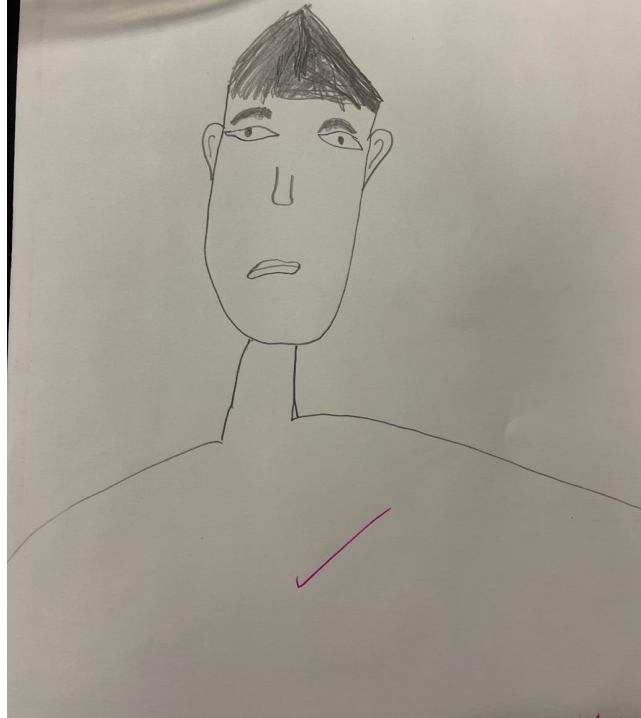
The children learned what a self-portrait was. They then identified the features needed in a self-portrait and had a going at drawing their own using simple lines and shapes.

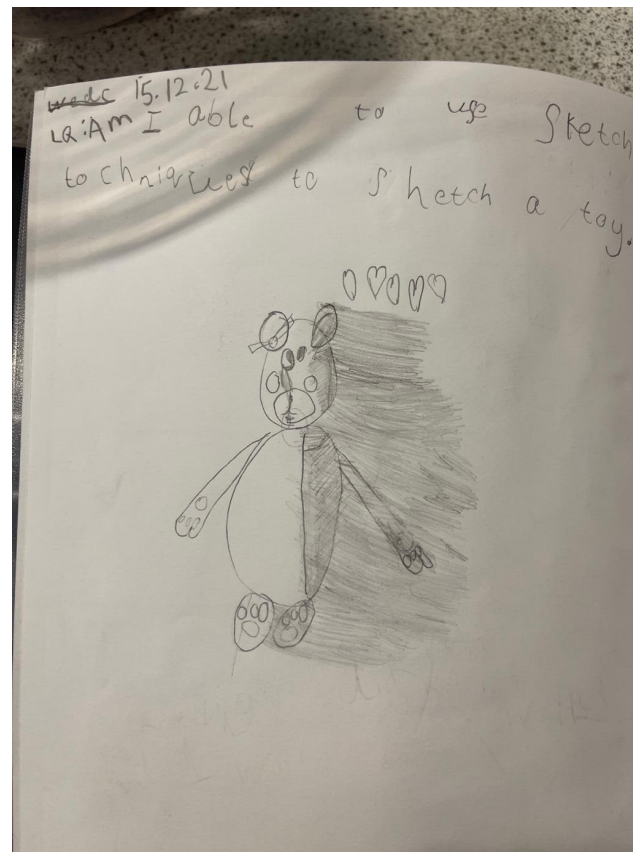
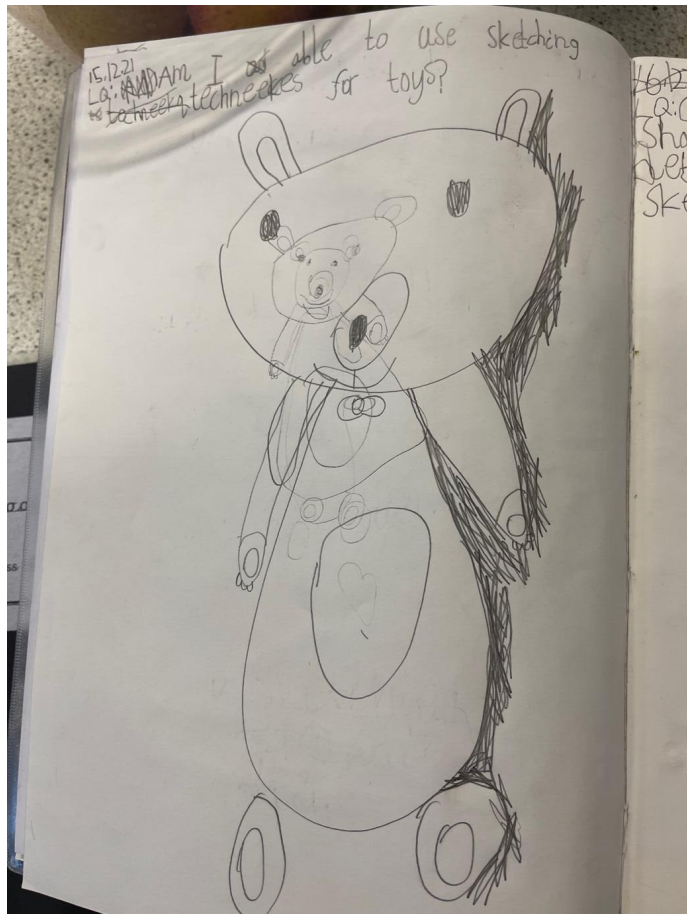

LQ: Am I able to use sketching techniques to sketch a toy?

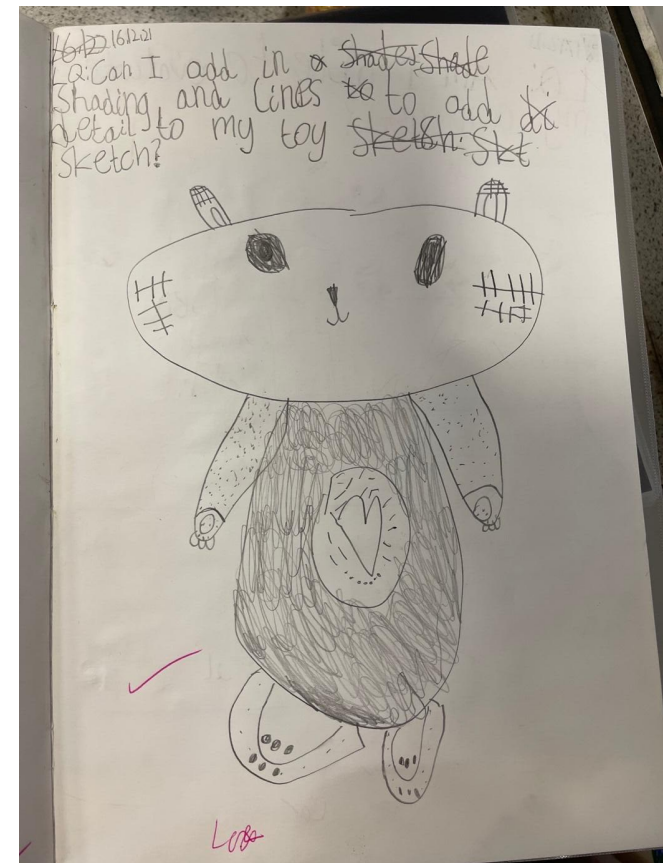
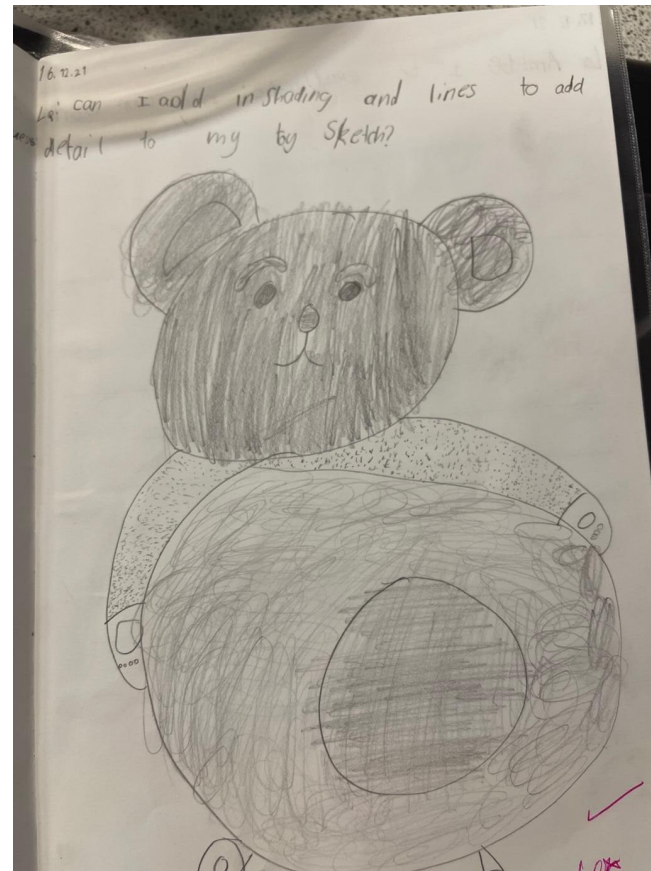
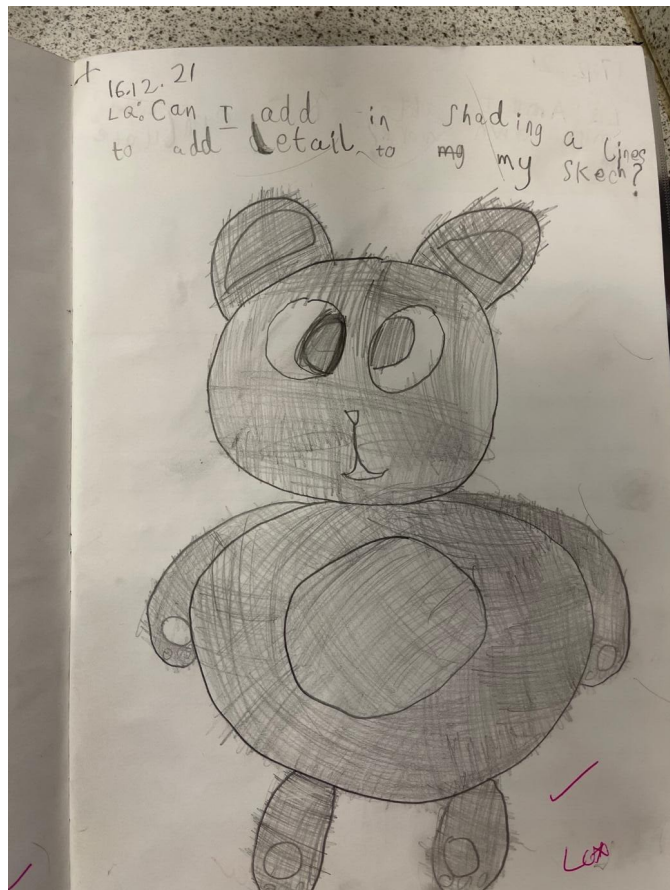
In this lesson the children took their chosen toy and studied the outline of it. The children then used previously taught techniques to draw the outline of it.
