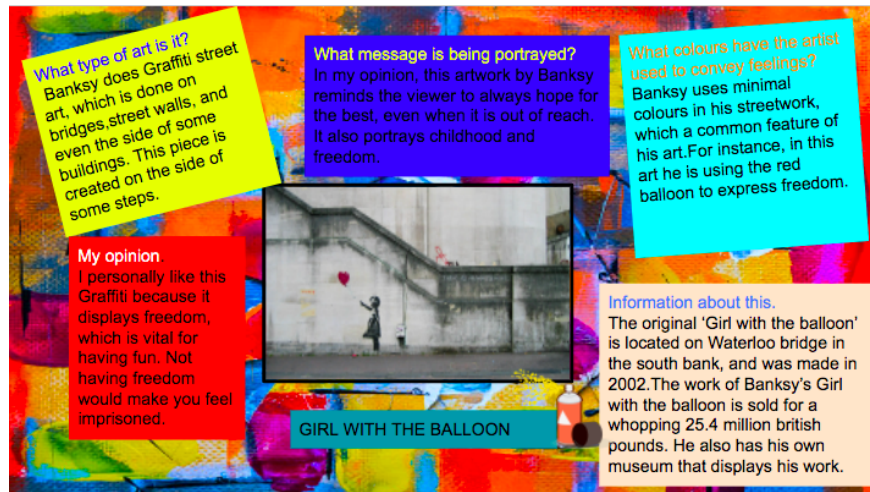
Summer 1 Digital Art

Intent of the unit:

During this unit, students will analyze and research the work of Banksy (an English based street artist). The children will look at a variety of his pieces to understand how he uses his artwork (generally subversive epigrams) to portray a message based on current political, social and environmental issues. From their research and artistic evaluations children will formulate their own ideas to portray in their artwork. Children will then express their ideas through the use of '2paint a pic' on Purplemash software and through learning the Banksy techniques of multi-layering as well as single line drawing and silhouetting. The students will then create 3 works of graffiti ensuring it meets the success criteria formulated. Finally, the children will display their final digital paintings on 'Padlet' to evaluate their own work along with their peers to identify strengths and weaknesses in the artwork.

Lesson 1- LQ: How can I analyse and evaluate the work of Banksy?

At the beginning of the lesson children were asked to evaluate a piece of work by Banksy. From here, the children formulated what a success criteria of the aspects of Banksy's work- i.e. reflecting a message, minimalistic etc. As a class we then used the 5 points of evaluation to evaluate Season's Greetings using the 5 points of evaluation. Children were then given their own chance of evaluating a piece by Banksy using key vocabulary they had learnt in the lesson.



What type of art is it?
Banksy does Graffiti street art, which is done on bridges, street walls, and even the side of some buildings. This piece is created on the side of some steps.

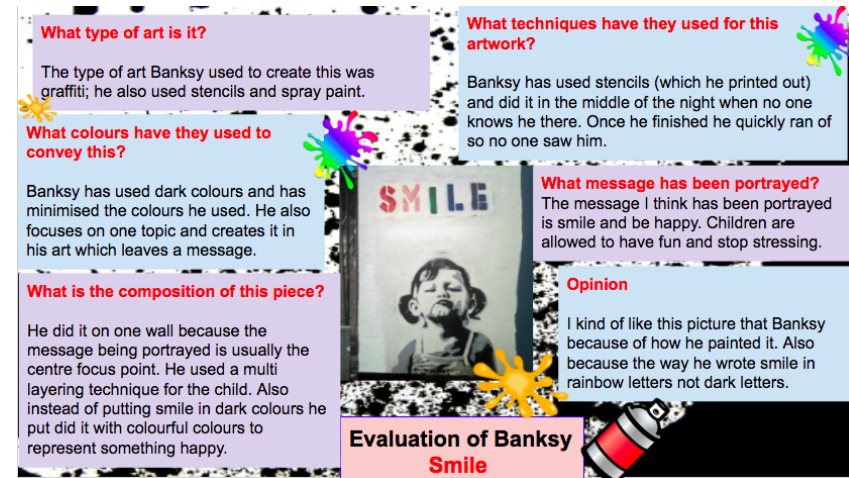
What message is being portrayed?
In my opinion, this artwork by Banksy reminds the viewer to always hope for the best, even when it is out of reach. It also portrays childhood and freedom.

What colours have the artist used to convey feelings?
Banksy uses minimal colours in his streetwork, which is a common feature of his art. For instance, in this art he is using the red balloon to express freedom.

My opinion
I personally like this Graffiti because it displays freedom, which is vital for having fun. Not having freedom would make you feel imprisoned.

Information about this.
The original 'Girl with the balloon' is located on Waterloo bridge in the south bank, and was made in 2002. The work of Banksy's Girl with the balloon is sold for a whopping 25.4 million British pounds. He also has his own museum that displays his work.

What type of art is it?
The type of art Banksy used to create this was graffiti; he also used stencils and spray paint.

Banksy has used stencils (which he printed out) and did it in the middle of the night when no one knows he there. Once he finished he quickly ran off so no one saw him.

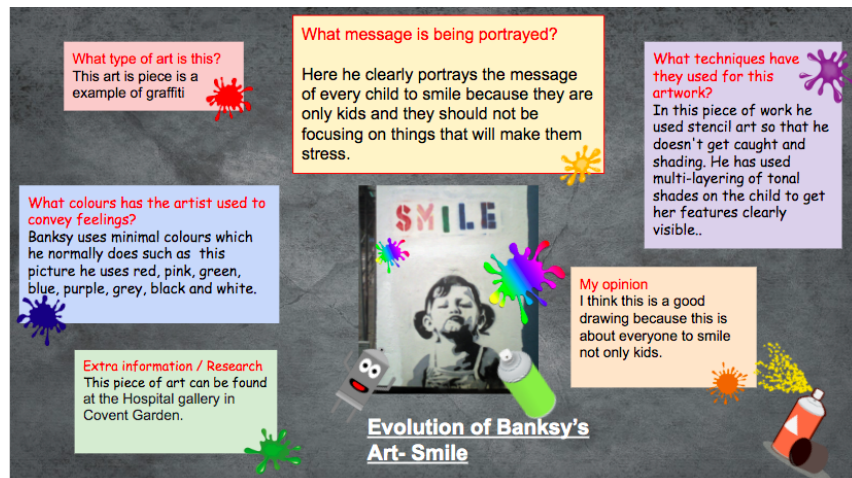
What colours have they used to convey this?

He did it on one wall because the message being portrayed is usually the centre focus point. He used a multi layering technique for the child. Also instead of putting smile in dark colours he put did it with colourful colours to represent something happy.

Here he clearly portrays the message of every child to smile because they are only kids and they should not be focusing on things that will make them stress.

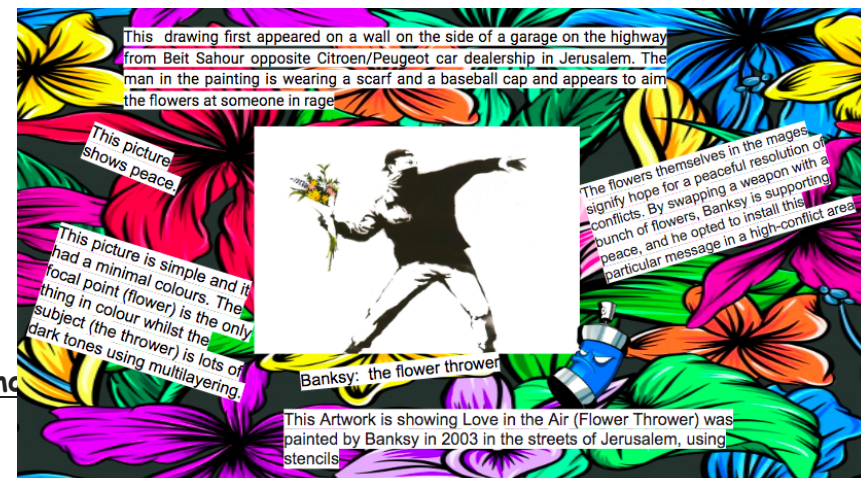
What techniques have they used for this artwork?

Banksy uses minimal colours which he normally does such as this picture he uses red, pink, green, blue, purple, grey, black and white.

Evolution of Banksy's Art- Smile



This drawing first appeared on a wall on the side of a garage on the highway from Beit Sahour opposite Citroen/Peugeot car dealership in Jerusalem. The man in the painting is wearing a scarf and a baseball cap and appears to aim the flowers at someone in rage.

This picture shows peace.

This picture is simple and it had a minimal colours. The focal point (flower) is the only thing in colour whilst the subject (the thrower) is lots of dark tones using multilayering.

The flowers themselves in the images signify hope for a peaceful resolution of conflicts. By swapping a weapon with a bunch of flowers, Banksy is supporting peace, and he opted to install this particular message in a high-conflict area.

This Artwork is showing Love in the Air (Flower Thrower) was painted by Banksy in 2003 in the streets of Jerusalem, using stencils.

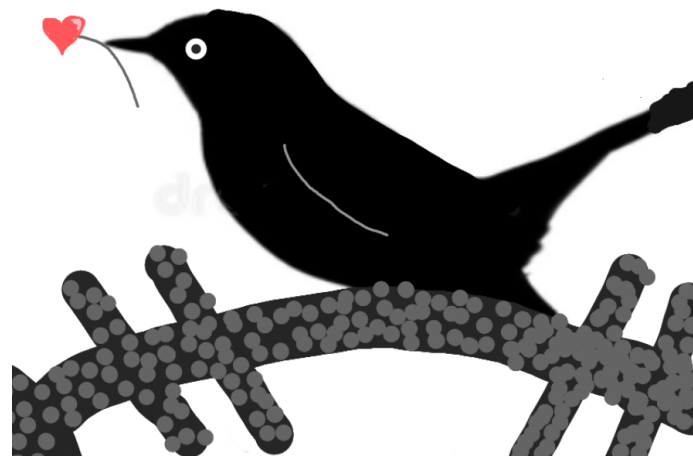
Planning alteration for next year: Highlight they can only choose ONE theme to find pictures for as children were collecting lots of different images initially.



Lesson 3- How will I design my pottery to replicate an ancient Greek artefact which tells a story?

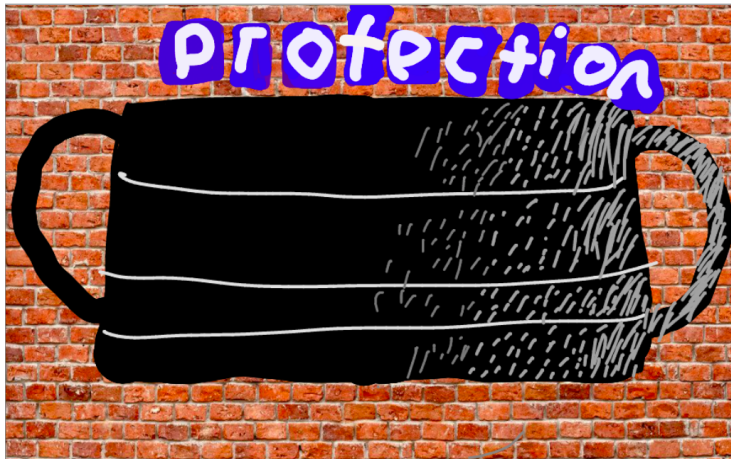
During this lesson the children used the ideas they collected from their theme yesterday to create a range of Banksy style images. The children first had a go at using black tones to form their epigram silhouette before building on top using a range of sketching techniques such as dotting, hatching and cross hatching. The children got familiar with using the Purple Mash features such as the finer/wider brush tool, water tool for diluting colours to form lighter shades and also the zoom in tool for detailing. Teachers may need more guidance prior to this lesson to know exactly what the outcomes should be like.

Lesson 4- How will I use my design and equipment correctly to decorate my pot?

In this lesson, the children choose their favourite image they created from the previous lesson to use for their final piece. The chromebooks were flipped and used padlets so children could use their fingers as their paint brush. Children found a suitable textured background wall for their image before working on top of it. (May need to be done over 2 lessons next year).

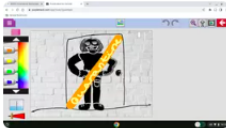
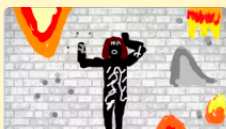
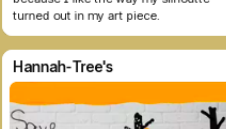
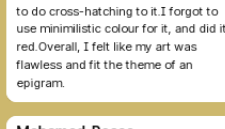


Lesson 5- How can I use my success criteria to evaluate my work?

The children of Year 5 saved their images using screen capture technology to save onto their chromebooks. The children then uploaded their images onto a Padlet page to evaluate their piece. The children used the five points of evaluation: category, communication, composition, colours, techniques to explain their final piece. The children then reflected on the strengths and weaknesses of their pieces.

Main weaknesses across Year 5: Use of the zoom in tool for further detail, incorporating too much colour. Will need to be highlighted more in planning for next year.

Unit may need 6 lessons instead of time- ran out of time.

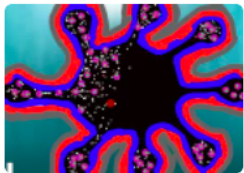

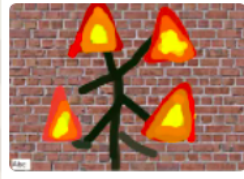

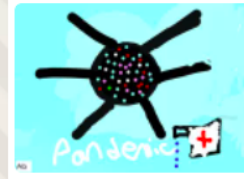
