










<p style="text-align: center;">Culture</p> 	<p>Culture is a pattern of behavior shared by a society, or group of people. Many different things make up a society's culture. These things include food, language, clothing, tools, music, arts, customs, beliefs, and religion.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Pattern</p> 	<p>A pattern is something that happens or appears in a regular and repeated way.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Cultural Pattern</p> 	<p>Patterns are used throughout cultures to represent events, add value to artwork and communicate thoughts (symbols).</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Geometric pattern</p> 	<p>These patterns are linear and come in the form of shapes e.g. squares, circles, chevrons etc.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Symbolic pattern</p> 	<p>These patterns are natural e.g. animals, flowers, seeds, trees etc.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Iconography</p> 	<p>Communicating in artwork through the use of symbols. Each symbol represents a word and together they tell a story.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Sgraffito</p> 	<p>A painting technique, which involves painting a thin layer of paint and then scratching patterns into the wet paint.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Scumbling</p> 	<p>A painting technique which involves using a thin layer of paint and moving the paint brush in a circular movement creating a softer effect.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Stencil</p> 	<p>Applying paint or other materials to designated gaps that have been designed to create an image.</p>
