

Town – an area that is usually bigger than a village but smaller than a city. More people live in a town.



Countryside – land outside towns and cities, with fields, woods, etc.



Urban – an area where many people live and work close together. The population is higher than in the surrounding area and buildings are close together.



Rural – areas which are not towns or cities. They are often farming or agricultural areas.



Crops – living plants grown by farmers.
Most crops are foods such as grain,
vegetables, or fruit.



Village – small settlements with a small number of houses for a few hundred people.



Settlement – places where people live and sometimes work.



City – the largest kind of settlements and often have millions of people living in them, e.g. London.
