goods and services



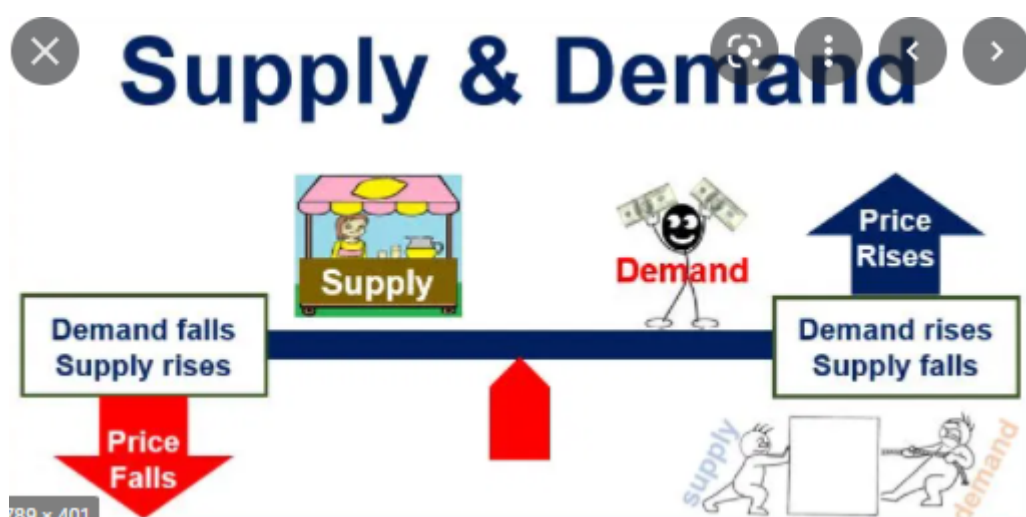
industry - economic activity concerned with the processing of raw materials and manufacture of goods in factories



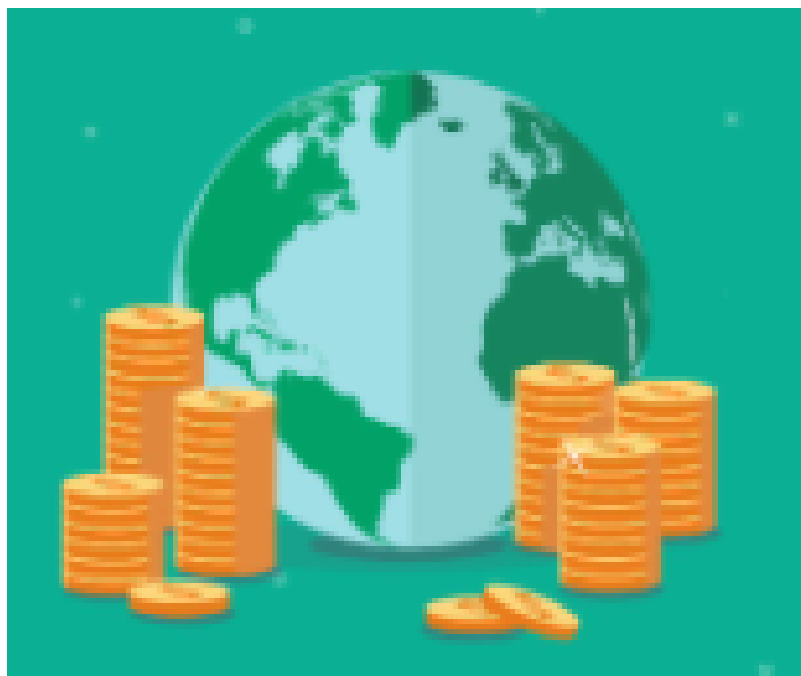
manufacturer - a person

producers



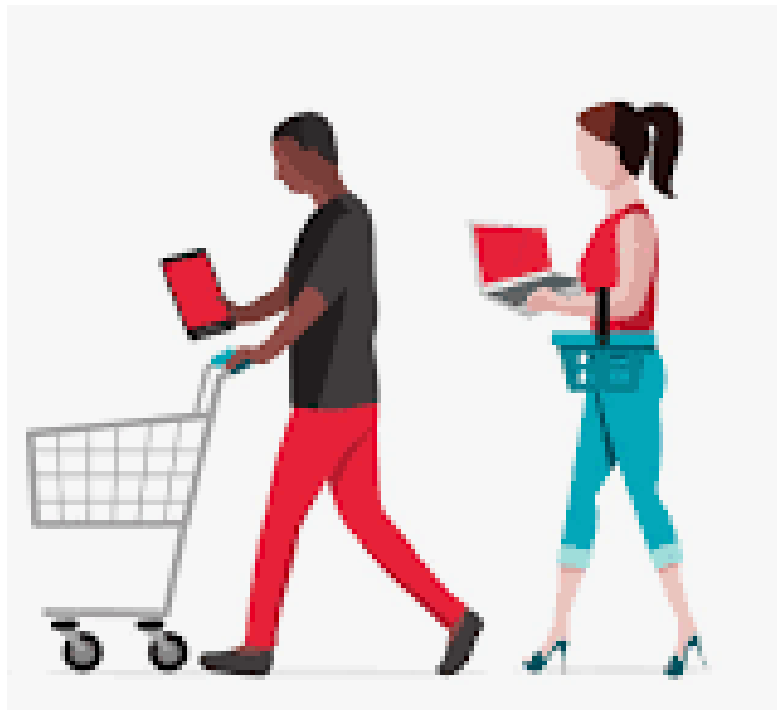
production - the action
