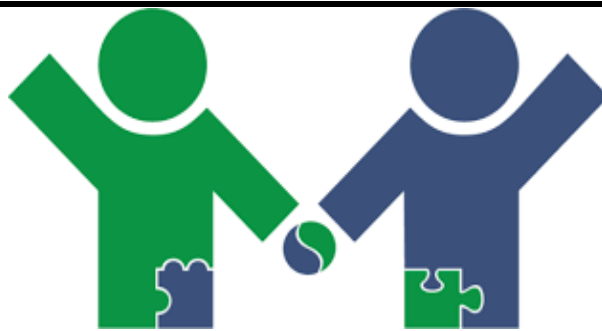




## **ration** (noun)

a fixed amount of a commodity officially allowed to each person during a time of shortage, as in wartime



## **allies** (noun)

a group or nation that is associated with others for some common cause or purpose



## **Blitz** (noun)

an intensive or sudden military attack



## **slogan** (noun)

a short and striking or memorable phrase used in advertising



## **Prime Minister** (noun)

the head of an elected government



## **evacuee (noun)**

a person evacuated from a place of danger



## **telegram (noun)**

message sent by telegraph and then delivered in written or printed form



## **Anderson Shelter (noun)**

a small prefabricated air-raid shelter



## **Nazi (noun)**

a member of the National Socialist German Workers' Party



## **Gas mask (noun)**

a protective mask used to cover a person's face as a defence against poison gas



## **siren** (noun)

a device that makes a loud prolonged signal or warning sound



## **occupied** (adj)

taken control of by someone else



## **host family** (noun)

family to look after evacuees



## **invade** (verb)

armed forces enter a country or region so as to occupy it



## **air raid** (noun)

an attack in which bombs are dropped from aircraft on to a ground target



## **propaganda (noun)**

information, especially of a biased or misleading nature, used to promote a political cause or point of view



## **blackout (noun)**

a period when all lights must be turned out or covered to prevent them being seen by the enemy during an air raid



**civilians (noun)**

a person not in the armed services or the police  
force



**fuhrer (noun)**

a tyrannical leader



**volunteer** (noun)

a person who freely offers to take part in an enterprise or undertake a task



**conscript** (noun)

a person enlisted compulsorily



## **conscientious objector (noun)**

a person who for reasons of conscience objects to serving in the armed forces



## **reparations (noun)**

the action of making amends for a wrong one has done, by providing payment or other assistance to those who have been wronged
