

**Guru Granth Sahib** – the most important Sikh scripture. Sikhs believe this to be an eternal living guru



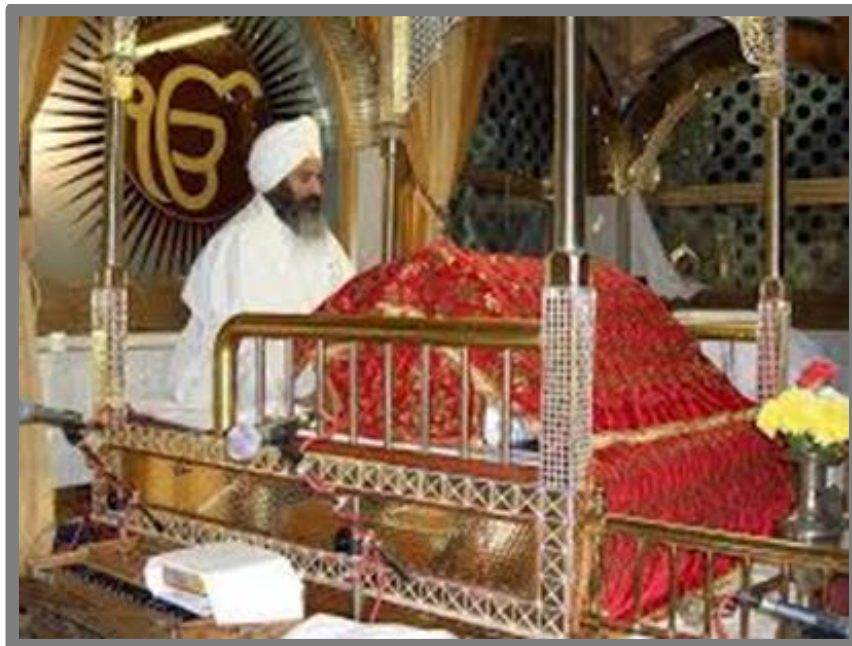
**Ten gurus** - the spiritual masters of Sikhism



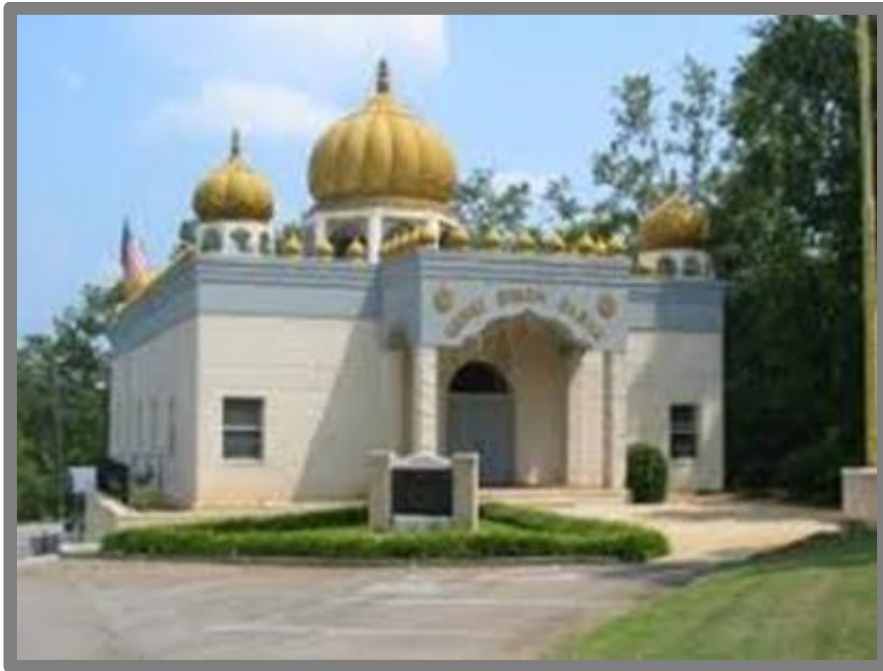
# Guru Nanak – the founder of Sikhism



**Takht** – a throne or seat of authority



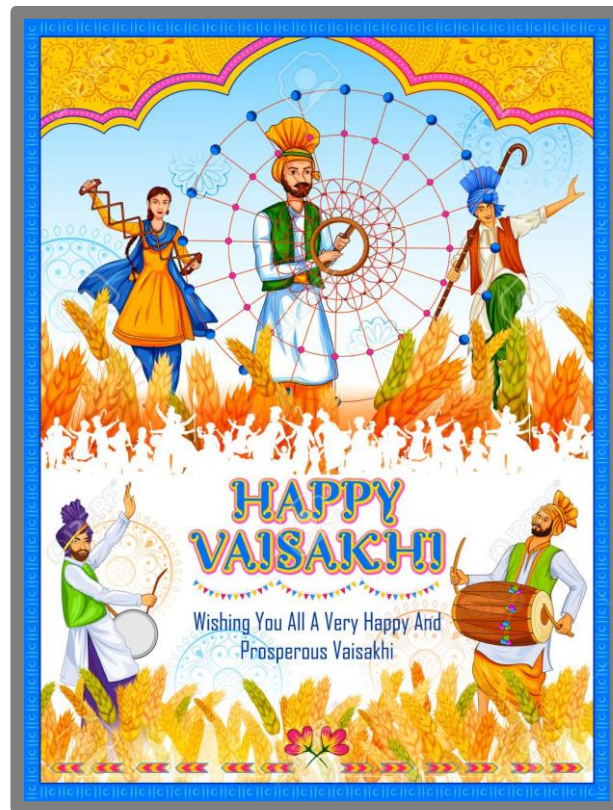
**Gurdwara** - the place where Sikh's come together for worship



**Chaur** – a ceremonial fan made of yak hair and waved over the Guru Granth Sahib



**Vaisakhi** – a festival surrounding the Sikh community



**Ik Onkar** – the symbol that represents the one supreme reality



**Nishan Sahib** - a Sikh triangular flag made of cotton or silk cloth, with a tassel at its end.



**Khanda** - the symbol of the Sikh faith



**Kirpan** - a sword or a dagger of any size and shape, carried by Sikhs



**Kachera** - a shalwar-undergarment with a tie-knot worn by baptized Sikhs



**Kara** - a steel or cast iron (sarb loh) bangle worn by Sikhs



**Kangha** - a small wooden comb that Sikhs usually use twice a day



**Kesh** - the practice of allowing one's hair to grow naturally out of respect for the perfection of God's creation
