

Kosher- Food that follows the Jewish dietary needs.



Treif- Food that does not follow the Jewish dietary needs and is therefore forbidden.



Halal- (meaning *permissible*) Food that follows Islamic laws. Food that does not follow the Islamic laws is referred to as 'haram'.



Eid El Fitr- A festival in Islam when Ramadan (month of fasting) is over.



Yom Kippur- A period of fasting in Judaism, usually occurring between September to October.



Vesak- A festival that marks the birth, teachings and death of Buddha. Buddhists celebrate and share food with others.



Vaisakhi/Baisakhi- A Sikh festival that marks the Punjabi New Year. It also celebrates 1699, the year when Sikhism was born as a faith.



Mundan:

A Hindu child's first haircut.



Wesak:

A celebration of Buddha's birth.
