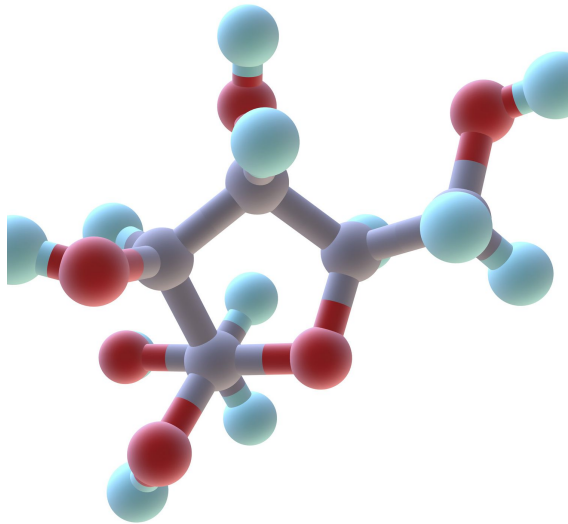


Structure



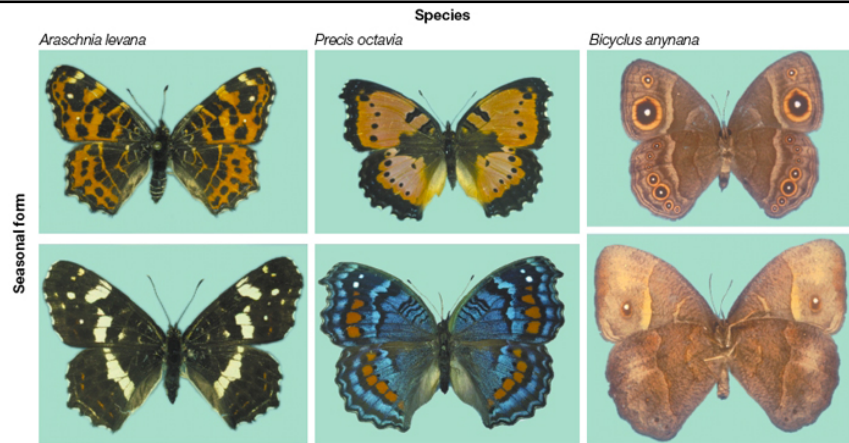
How something is constructed.

e.g. tweaking a method

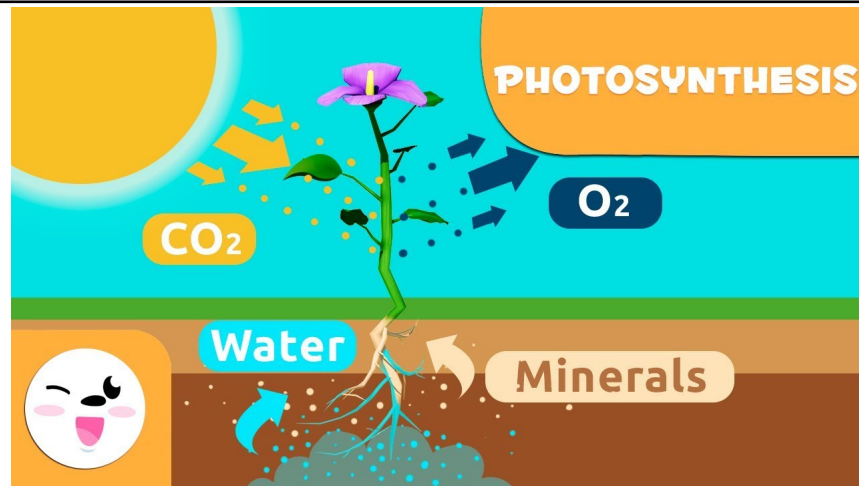
Formation



How something is formed.

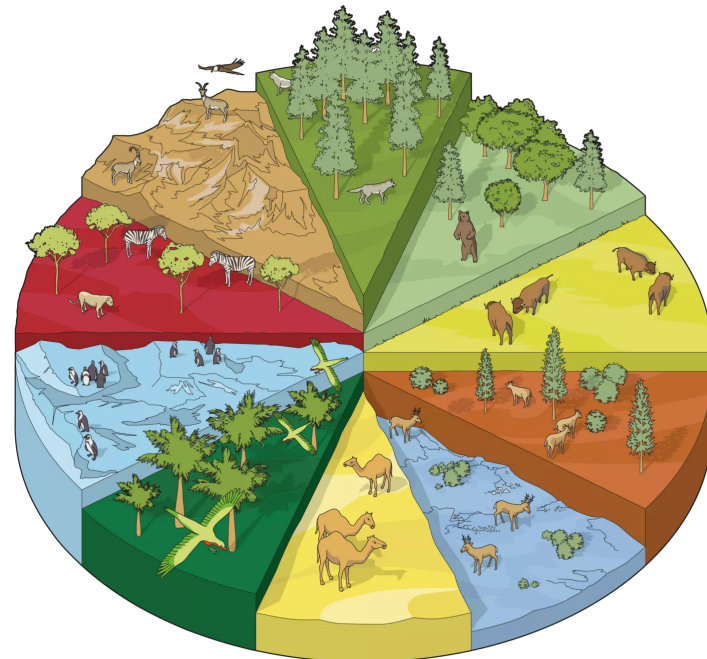
e.g. rocks, space, DNA

Function



To work or operate in a proper or particular way.

Habitats



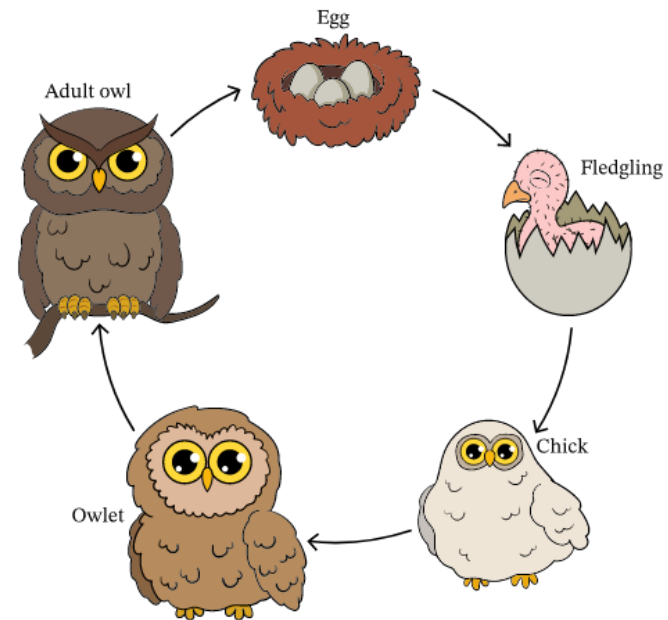
The natural home or environment of an animal, plant, or other organism.
