

Rocks – A naturally occurring solid mass from minerals



Soil – a mixture of organic matter, minerals, gases, liquids, and organisms that together support life



Permeable – A layer that allows liquids or gases to pass through



Fossils – any preserved remains, impression, or trace of any once-living thing from a past geological age



Igneous - formed from molten rock that has cooled and solidified



Sedimentary – Rocks that are formed from the build-up of many layers of particles and become solid by combining together



Metamorphic – A rock that is changed from another by heat or pressure
