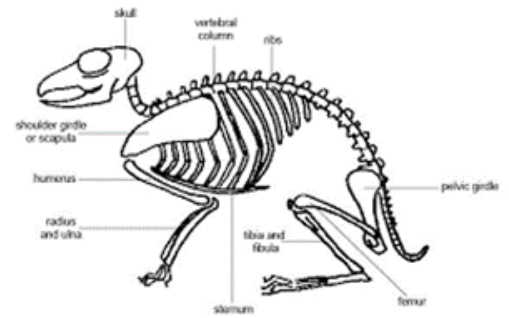


Vertebrate- is an animal with a backbone.

Mammal- an animal that breathes air, has a backbone, and grows hair at some point during its life. In addition, all female mammals have glands that can produce milk.



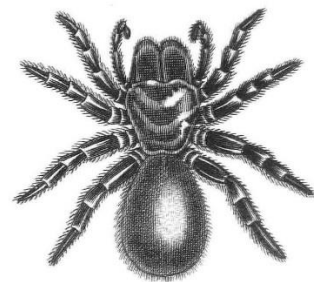
Amphibians are cold-blooded animals with skeletons inside their bodies.



Crustacean is an animal with a hard shell and several pairs of legs, which usually lives in water.



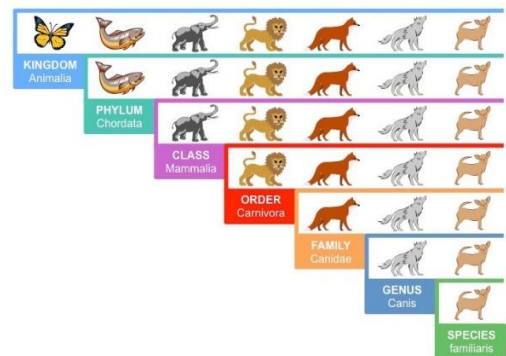
Arachnids - have eight legs, and unlike insects, they don't have antennae.
