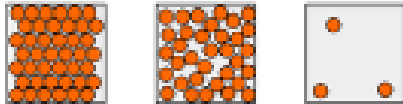




Particles:

a tiny amount or small piece; speck;
trace e.g. There's a particle of dirt on
your glasses.

The 3 States of Matter



State:

the condition of a person or thing e.g.
The old house was in a bad state.



Evaporation:

to turn from liquid into gas e.g. When
water evaporates, it becomes water
vapor.






Condensation:

the act or process of changing from a
gas to a liquid e.g. The condensation of
steam from the boiling tea kettle
made the window fog up.



Precipitation:

the act of water falling in the form of
rain, snow, sleet, or hail e.g. The
weather report predicted
precipitation today.

	<p>Melting/Boiling/Freezing Point: the temperature at which a given object changes state through melting, boiling or freezing.</p>
	<p>Reversible able to be turned the other way round.</p>
	<p>Irreversible not able to be undone or altered.</p>
